




St. Mary- East Dubuque (K-8)




Enrollment Losses Most Common Reasons Given

St. Mary - E. Dubuque PK and K-8 Enrollment



St. Mary Catholic School – East Dubuque K to 8 in 2016-17




With a capacity of 100, 48 seats empty

Infant baptisms: 28% decline 2010-2014

First Eucharist: 31% decline 2011-2014

Average 20 a year for First Eucharist

Mass attendance: 13% decline 2009-2014

• In 2014 four parishes had estimated 1,525 people attending Mass

Infant baptisms: 11% decline 2010-2014





Per Pupil Cost & Average Tuition Paid by K-8 Enrollment




Per Pupil Cost & Average Tuition Paid by K-8 Enrollment
